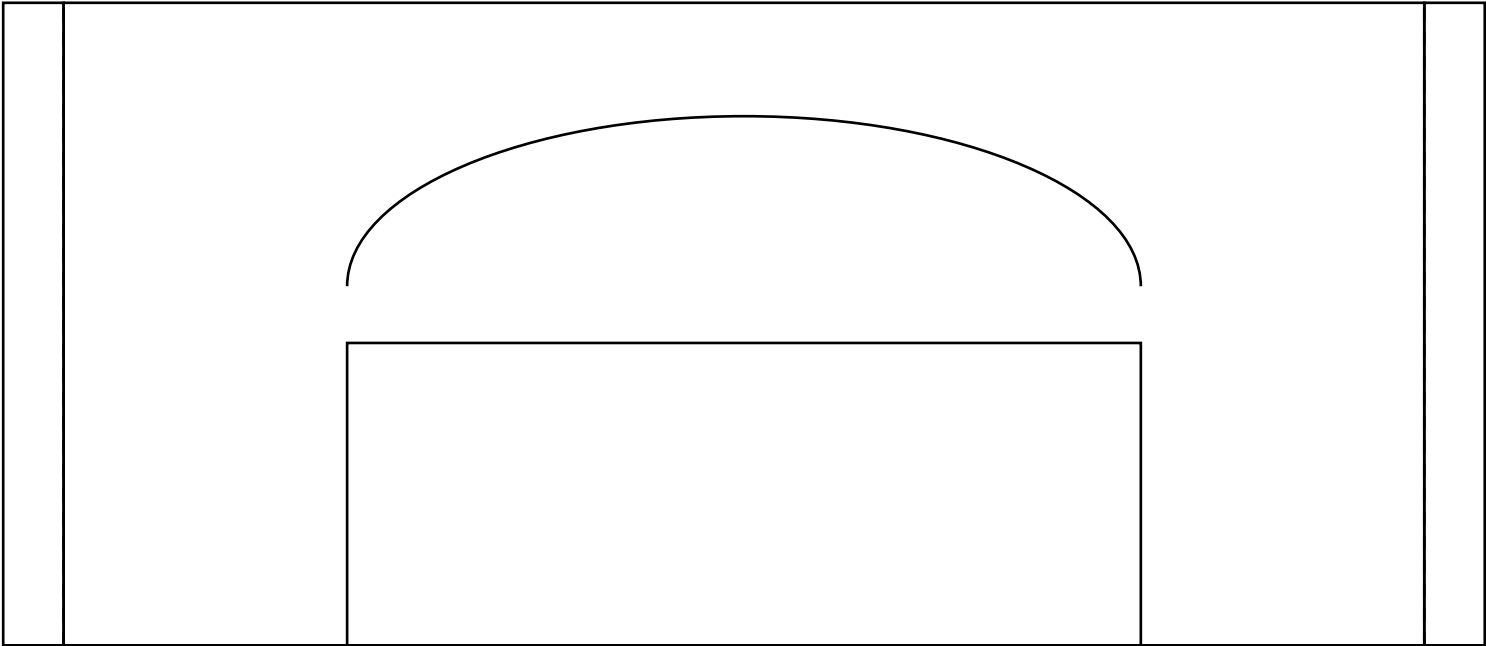
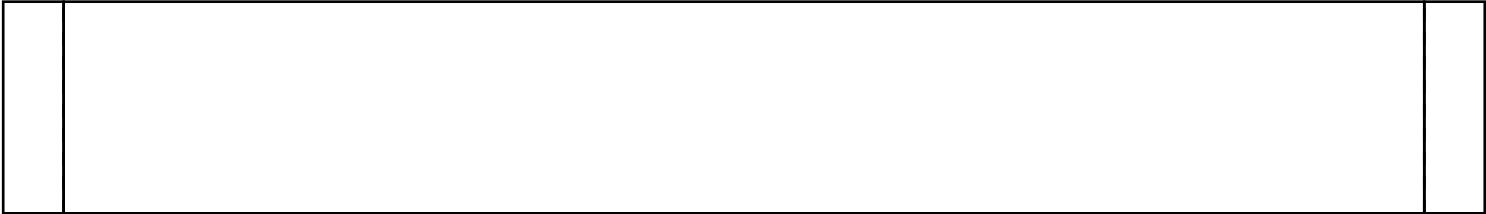


DEN FRONT & BACK - cut solid lines; fold dashed tabs

FRONT - adult help recommended for cutting cave opening



BACK LOWER PANEL



Fold connector tabs inward and glue between the front and back.

ROOF

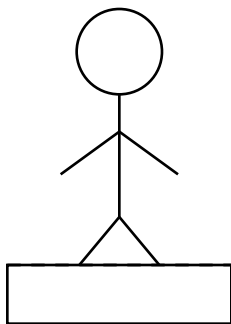
LEFT SIDE

RIGHT SIDE

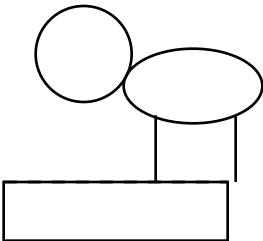
Finished den: approx. 18 cm (7 in) wide x 10 cm (4 in) high x 9 cm (3.5 in) deep.

Print at 100% / Actual Size. Recommended: 65 lb / ~176 gsm cardstock.

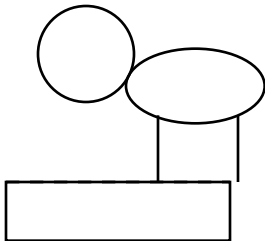
Fold the figure bases backward. Glue ONLY the stone hinge tab to the den.



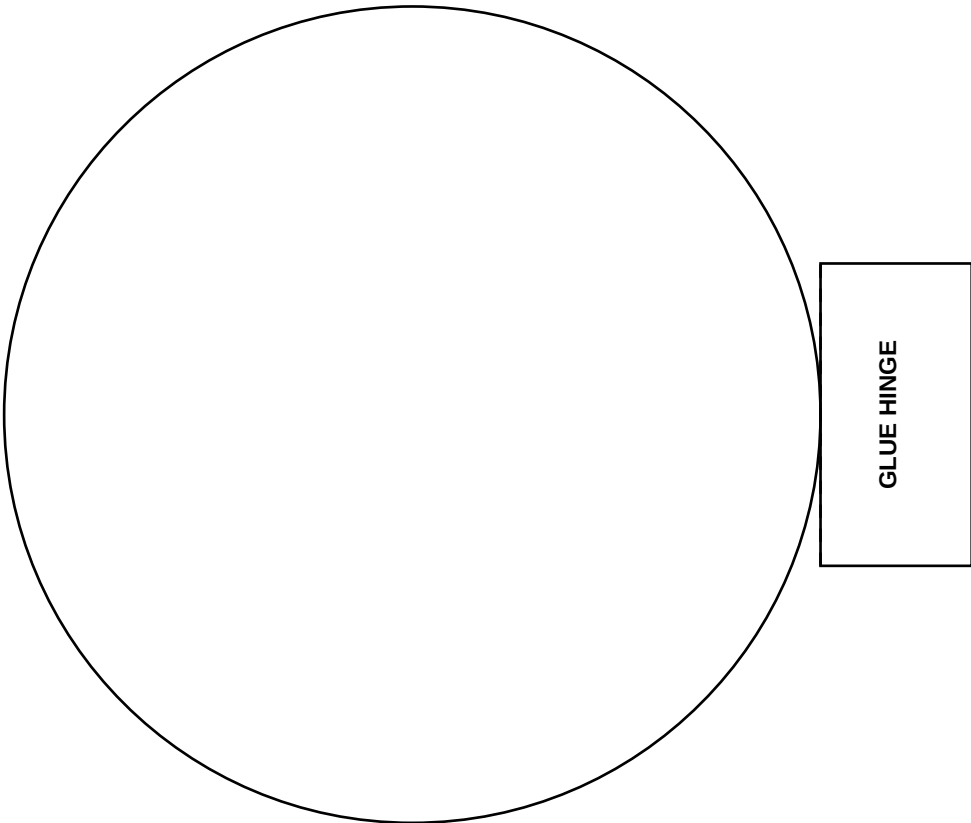

STONE DOOR - approx. 10.8 cm / 4.25 in

Build - Close the Stone - Open and Tell the Story

1. COLOR - Color all pieces before cutting.
2. CUT - Cut around solid outlines. Adult help for the cave opening.
3. FOLD - Fold all dashed tabs inward and fold figure bases backward.
4. BUILD - Glue floor, roof and side connectors between front and back.
5. ADD FIGURES - Stand Daniel and the two lions inside.
6. ADD STONE - Glue only the 2 cm hinge tab beside the cave opening.
7. PLAY - Close and open the stone while retelling Daniel 6.

Large pieces and 0.8 cm glue tabs are easier for small hands.

The den uses separate flat connector strips rather than a complicated one-piece net.

The stone is attached on one side only, so the paper hinge can open and close.

Finished size is large enough for Daniel and two stand-up lions.

Recommended for children with adult help for cutting and gluing.
